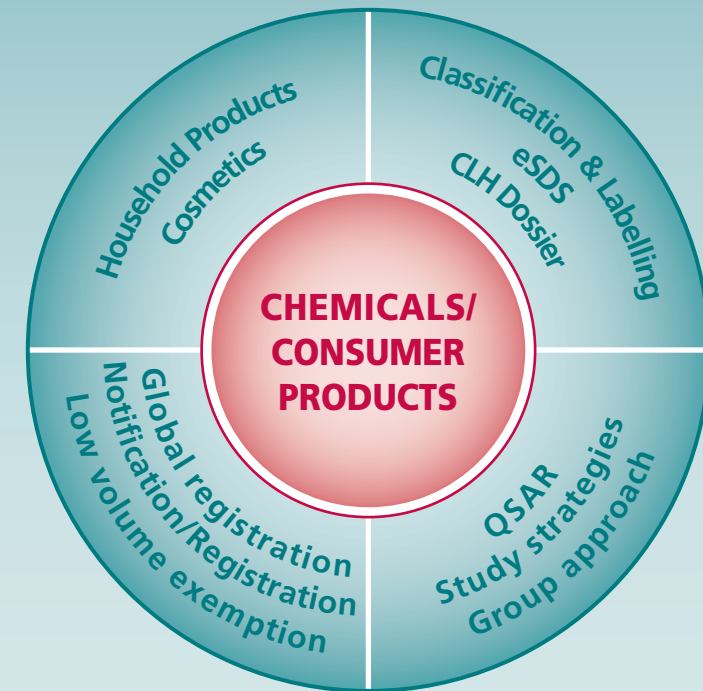

- Fast track notification: performance of all required studies (e.g. for REACH Annex VII), and notification to ECHA can be achieved within 4-5 months.

- Independent scientific and regulatory study monitoring by SCC. Studies are replaced by scientific expert statements where possible and economically and scientifically justified.
- World-wide acceptance of studies.
